**Subject:** **Reminder on Assembly Bill 1114**

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Dear IEHP Provider,

We would like to inform you that Inland Empire Health Plan (IEHP) pays for the pharmacy provided services as outlined in California Assembly Bill 1114.

Under AB 1114, pharmacist services are rendered as a benefit under the Medi-Cal program and the pharmacists can be reimbursed for providing services to a Medi-Cal beneficiary. These services include: initiating and administering immunizations, furnishing self-administered contraception, nicotine replacement therapy, naloxone, travel medicines and HIV pre-exposure and post-exposure prophylaxis (PrEP/PEP). To be eligible for the reimbursement, pharmacist must be enrolled as an ordering, referring, and prescribing (ORP) provider under Medi-Cal, and the services must be billed by a Medi-Cal enrolled pharmacy. The rate of reimbursement for pharmacist services is set at 85% of the fee schedule for physician services under the Medi-Cal program.

Here is the list of CPT codes that are eligible for the reimbursement:
