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Inland Empire Health Plan (IEHP) has made the following updates to the 2024 Global Quality (GQ) P4P PCP Program Guide:

### **Eligibility and Participation: Updates**

- We have updated one of the participation requirements for Providers:
  - “Have at least 200 Medi-Cal Members including Covered California (**per Provider location**), assigned as of July 2024.”

### **NEW Measure**

- ★ **NEW! Depression Screening and Follow-Up for Adolescents and Adults (DSF-E)**
  - *Measure Description:* The percentage of Members 12 years of age and older screened for clinical depression during the measurement year (2024) using a standardized instrument and, if screened positive, received follow-up care in the measurement year (2024).
    - This measure will assess the depression screening and follow-up care for those Members who screen positive for depression.
    - Please reference the 2024 Global Quality P4P Program Guide for full details on screening tools.
