Subject: Effective May 1, 2025 - PCPs Must Submit Referrals for Specified Ancillary

Services

Effective May 1, 2025, Ancillary (Physical Therapy (PT)/Speech Therapy (ST)/Occupational Therapy (OT) /Durable Medical Equipment (DME)/Home Health (HH) Providers will no longer have access to request referrals, whether initial or continued services for Members.

Ancillary Providers will need to work directly with the Member's PCP or treating Specialist, to request services.

How Should PCPs Assist¹?

- ✓ Please assist Members by submitting referrals for PT/ST/OT/DME/HH services as medically necessary
- ✓ To avoid delays in care, please partner with Ancillary Providers to ensure that the requested authorizations are submitted completely and timely
- ✓ PCP oversight is vital to ensuring whether a Member requires continuing care

¹ PCPs are responsible for supervising, coordinating, and providing initial primary care to patients; for initiating referrals; for maintaining the continuity of patient care, and for serving as the Medical Home for Members. PCP and Specialist requests for referral to specialty care should be initiated through the Member's IPA. Please see Policies 14A1, "Review Procedures – Primary Care Provider (PCP) Referrals" and 14D, "Pre-Service Referral Authorization Process."
