Subject: REMINDER – Early Start Program – Refer and Review

The Early Start Program provides coordinated and family-centered, early intervention services for infants and toddlers with disabilities and their families, following an assessment outlined in an Individual Family Service Plan (IFSP).

**Refer Members** by filling out an online referral form at <u>inlandrc.org/eligibility</u> if you suspect a child (ages 0-36 months) may have a developmental delay in one or more of the following areas:

Cognitive

• Receptive Communication

• Expressive Communication


Social

• Emotional

Adaptive

Motor Development (Vision and Hearing)

<u>Review the Early Start roster regularly on our secure portal</u> to confirm your patients who may be accessing services through Inland Regional Center and coordinate care accordingly:





- Select **Rosters** from the navigation panel and then **Early Start Roster**.
- When checking Member Eligibility, an **alert** will appear indicating if a Member is enrolled in the Early Start Program. Clicking the alert will also reroute you to the roster.
