Subject:	Academic Detailing Services Now Offered

Inland Empire Health Plan's (IEHP) Pharmacy Academic Detailing is an educational and evidence-based outreach program for our providers and pharmacies.

The IEHP Academic Detailing Pharmacists and Pharmacy Technicians are trained outreach educators that perform phone, virtual, and one-on-one outreach with physicians, nurse practitioners, physician assistants, and pharmacy staff. Our goal is to transform the prescriber and pharmacy practice and enhance the provider, pharmacist, and member experience.

Our team is working closely with Riverside University Health System (RUHS), San Francisco Department of Public Health's (SFPH) Academic Detailing team, Center for Innovation in Academic Detailing on Opioids (CIAO), and the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) to provide detailing services, resources, and information on **safe opioid prescribing for chronic pain** to our providers.

This service available to providers will help **reduce opioid-related overdose morbidity and mortality in our communities and protect IEHP members**.

Opioids and Chronic Pain Topics include but not limited to:

- Naloxone & Opioid Tapering
- Recognizing Opioid Use Disorder (OUD)
- Controlled substance monitoring
- > Buprenorphine
