Have Questions? Below are answers to many questions you may have about the Provider Quality App.

Q What is the Provider Quality App?

A Provider Quality App is a web-based application designed to help Primary Care Physicians (PCPs) maximize their efforts in the Global Quality (GQ) Pay for Performance (P4P) Program by empowering them to engage the right Members at the right time and informing them about their quality performance through its:

- Custom roster and measure-based care gap roster
- Payout, quality performance, and measure dashboards
- Insights into opportunities for improving quality of care for IEHP Members
- GQ P4P resources and support tools

Q Where can I access this application, and will I need separate login credentials?

A Provider Quality Application can be accessed via the **Reports** section of IEHP's [Provider Portal](#) or a [direct link](#) and DOES NOT require separate login credentials.

Q Does this Provider Quality App replace the current Global Quality P4P Reports?

A No. This application is designed to complement and is consistent with the existing GQ P4P reports and related member rosters, is based on the same underlying data sources, and serves as an additional tool to help Providers get the most out of the P4P Program.
