IEHP's Guideline Review Committee has approved the following authorization guideline updates/changes, **effective** 9/1/2025:

Guideline #	Guideline Title	Degree of Change	Updates/Changes
UM_DIA 17	Genetic Testing	N/A New	 Genetic testing is the analysis of DNA, RNA, or proteins to identify changes in molecular sequence that may be associated with disease. Indications for testing include: (1) to confirm the diagnosis of a genetic disease. (2) to identify genetic factors that may increase the risk of developing disease. (3) to determine the risk of having children with a genetic disease in high-risk couples. (4) to determine the effectiveness of treatment options and (5) to identify diseases in fetal or newborn members. Due to the sheer volume of tests currently in existence, developing a guideline to address each individual test would not be possible. Therefore, IEHP has created a guideline to assist in the review and determination of the medical necessity of these requests
