We are pleased to announce the launch of our new **Diabetes Prevention Program (DPP)** - a year-long, evidence-based lifestyle change program designed to support individuals who are newly diagnosed with prediabetes or are at high risk for developing type 2 diabetes.

Early intervention is key to preventing the progression of diabetes and improving long-term health outcomes.

Our DPP offers participants the tools, education, and support they need to make sustainable lifestyle changes that can significantly reduce their risk.

Program Benefits:

- Focus on nutrition, physical activity, and sustainable behavior change
- Group-based support in a culturally responsive environment
- Proven to reduce the risk of developing type 2 diabetes by over 50%

Who Should Be Referred?

- Adults with a diagnosis of prediabetes
- Individuals with a BMI \geq 25 (\geq 23 for Asian Americans)
- Patients with a history of gestational diabetes
- Those with risk factors such as family history, sedentary lifestyle, or elevated A1C

- Location: In-person classes at Variety Children's Charity of the Desert in Palm Desert
