Provider Guide: Requesting Additional VFC Vaccine Doses

Vaccine Ordering

How the California Vaccines for Children Program (VFC) Determines Order Size

- VFC bases the recommended order size on the doses the clinic reported as used in the last cycle.
 - Example: If 10 doses were used, VFC will suggest ordering 10 to replenish inventory.

When You Need More Doses

- If clinic demand has increased (e.g., extended hours, more providers, back-to-school season), you can request additional doses.
- Place justification directly on the order in the documentation area after entering quantities.
 - Example: If your clinic expects to use 50 doses, order 50 and document that you are operating at this level.

Approval Process

- A VFC representative will review the justification and decide whether to approve the request.
- Providers generally do not face issues getting an increased inventory during higher demand times (e.g., back-to-school).

Documentation Examples

 Include specific notes such as "Increase due to back-to-school demand" or "expanded clinic hours" when requesting more than the recommended order.
