Subject: **APL 25-015: Updated Immunization Recommendations**

This is an ad hoc notice in addition to our weekly bulletin due to the urgency of conveying regulatory updates.

On September 17, 2025, California Department of Public Health (CDPH) issued **updated guidance regarding COVID-19, influenza, and RSV immunizations.**

Per AB 144 all health care service plans must cover the CDPH-recommended immunizations without cost-sharing or utilization management.

Please note that the FDA currently recommends COVID-19 immunizations only for individuals 65 years of age or older or for those younger than 65 with at least one underlying condition that increases their risk of COVID-19. Notwithstanding the FDA's recommendation, per AB 144, health plans must cover COVID-19 immunizations per CDPH's recommendations even if doing so could be considered "off-label."
