**Subject:** Required: Optimal Care for Every Community (OCEC) Training & FAQs

The **Optimal Care for Every Community Training** is IEHP's designated DEI training program and has been released in accordance with the California Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) – All Plan Letter 24-016.

DHCS requires all Plan staff, Subcontractors, Downstream Subcontractors, and Network Providers to complete training on sensitivity, diversity, cultural competency, cultural humility, and health equity regardless of their cultural or professional training and background.

All Network Providers are required to complete this training by December 31, 2025. Thereafter, training must be completed by new providers within 90 days of their start date and once every recredentialing or contracting cycle, if the provider isn't subject to the recredentialing process.
