Subject: 2026 Global Quality P4P Program – Well-Child Visits Update

Inland Empire Health Plan (IEHP) would like to inform you of an update to the denominator anchor date language for the two measures listed below in the **2026 Global Quality P4P Program**. These updates were made to align the measures with the most recent HEDIS specifications.

Well-Child Visits in the First 15 Months of Life (W30)

The denominator anchor date is now defined as:

- **The child's 15th-month birthday plus 90 days.**

Well-Child Visits in the First 30 Months of Life (W30)

The denominator anchor date is now defined as:

- **The child's 30th-month birthday plus 180 days.**
