Subject: CORRECTION: 2026 Global Quality P4P Program Update – Well-Child Visits

Inland Empire Health Plan (IEHP) would like to issue a correction to the communication distributed on April 23, 2026, regarding the denominator anchor date language for Well-Child Visits in the First 15 Months of Life (W30) and Well-Child Visits in the First 30 Months of Life (W30) measures in the 2026 Global Quality P4P Program.

To align with the most recent HEDIS specifications, the denominator anchor dates should be defined as:

Well-Child Visits in the First 15 Months of Life (W30)

- The child's **1st birthday** plus 90 days.

Well-Child Visits in the First 30 Months of Life (W30)

- The child's **2nd birthday** plus 180 days.

This correction replaces the earlier referenced timeframes in the memo distributed on April 23, 2026.
