Subject: **Importance of Reporting Blood Pressure Values Using CPT II Codes**

Accurate and timely reporting of blood pressure values is essential to improving patient outcomes and ensuring reliable quality measurement across our network. To support this work, we are asking all providers to consistently submit blood pressure readings using the appropriate CPT II codes.

Submitting BP values through CPT II codes helps in several important ways:

- It improves our ability to identify and address gaps in care for members with hypertension.
- It ensures complete and accurate capture of clinical data needed for Provider Quality Incentive Programs.
- It reduces the need for chart requests and manual data collection, saving practices’ valuable time.
- It supports performance measurement that reflects the true quality of care delivered.

Please use the following CPT II codes when submitting blood pressure values. Codes must be submitted for both systolic and diastolic blood pressure values.

CPT II Codes for Systolic and Diastolic Blood Pressure

Systolic Blood Pressure Codes	
3074F	BP < 130 mm Hg
3075F	BP 130-139 mm Hg
3077F	BP ≥ 140 mm Hg
Diastolic Blood Pressure Codes	
3078F	BP<80 mm Hg
3079F	BP 80-89 mm Hg
3080F	BP ≥ 90 mm Hg

Please review your quality measure reports in the provider portal to identify patients with missing or incomplete blood pressure assessments. Schedule visits as needed to obtain accurate readings, discuss hypertension management, and submit the appropriate CPT II codes.
