What is MyPath?

The no-cost program serves members with advanced diseases, like cancer, congestive heart failure or Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease.

If you qualify, MyPath has a team to provide supportive services in your home and address your physical, mental, social, emotional and spiritual needs.

With extra support, you can live life on your terms. MyPath can help bring you a better quality of life.



How can MyPath Help You

You'll get care from a MyPath team of providers led by a doctor who works alongside your regular doctors.

You'll get help to:

- Manage your pain and symptoms
- Answer questions about your disease, medicines and treatment options
- Stay out of the emergency department and avoid being exposed to more health risks

Support When You Need It, 24/7

There are counseling services when you're feeling down or need help easing distress. A social worker is on hand as well as a chaplain.

The team can support you over the phone 24/7 and will conduct in-person visits during regular business hours, if needed.

Get Started

Call Member Services or ask your primary care doctor for a MyPath in-home consultation to see if you are eligible. After we arrange and complete the in-home visit, we will let you know if you qualify for the program and the next steps.
