Subject: **Accessible Clinics Program 2023**

Inland Empire Health Plan has created the Accessible Clinics Program (ACP) that aims to increase medical resources needed to provide better access and quality of care to more than 1.6 million Members.

How does it work?

ACP provides accessible exam table/scale combos for eligible network Providers in the Inland Empire, at no cost to the Provider. Experienced trainers are also available to assist you and your staff with the set-up and use of your new equipment.

How much does it cost?

Medical resources received via the program will belong to the Provider and will not require repayment. We simply want to improve access for our Members.

What can you do as an accessible clinic?

- Care for more Members with disabilities and/or physical limitations.
- Adequately examine patients for more effective treatment plans.
- Reduce workplace injuries, due to equipment mishandling, by taking advantage of the comprehensive training included with the program.
- Improve your Members' healthcare experience by offering equipment created with their needs in mind.
